Dr Justine McCarthy Woods: The History of the Rorschach in the UK

Dr Justine McCarthy Woods is a Consultant Clinical Psychologist, working in the NHS and privately with children, adolescents and adults. She co-founded the British Rorschach Society in 2007 and was President until 2016. She was a member of the Board of the International Society for the Rorschach from 2011to 2014. She has taught the Rorschach Comprehensive System in England, Hungary and Hong Kong. She is an Associate Editor of Rorschachiana.

Dr Sarah Hartley: Learning to use the Rorschach in clinical practice

Dr Sarah Hartley is the Treasurer of the British Rorschach Society. She trained to use the Rorschach in 2007 and has found it to be extremely useful in her practice with adults in the NHS and in the private sector, particularly when integrated with other psychometric tests. She is coauthor with Dr Carstairs of a chapter on how the Rorschach assists with the assessment of parents in care proceedings.

Dr Kari Carstairs: A normative study with 88 adults in England

Dr Kari Carstairs is the President of the British Rorschach Society, Consultant Test Editor for the British Psychological Society's Psychological Testing Centre, Diplomate of the American Board of Assessment Psychology and Fellow of the Society for Personality Assessment. She has taught the Rorschach Comprehensive system in England and Hong Kong and published case studies that illustrate how the test informs clinical practice.
